-The Convention Room gives us about 1000 sq feet to show

Some Details:

In order to assure quality standards (this benefits all artisans) we ask the astisans submitting work into this show to provide the VISG with images of the work that will be submitted into this show. Application form and digital images can be emailed to **VIsculptors@shaw.ca**. (Note the change in email address this year!) Please include dimensions as this will help to pre-set up the show footprint.

Our customers want your best original work. The VISG reserves the right to decline work.

All sculptures submitted into the show need to be offered for sale. No 'NFS' entries please.

The Sculptor's Guild Show and Sale is run by volunteers at the direction of the VISG committee. We have structured the commission fees to reflect your input. VISG will charge a commission of **35%** on sales by artisans who are unable to volunteer; **25%** if you volunteer for two shifts and **15%** if you volunteer for three or more shifts. The number of shifts necessary for commission discount is subject to change depending on the number of entrants. All commission money received will go directly back to the guild so that we can put on future shows, advertise for them, workshops, and activities to benefit the sculptors guild.

Demonstrations are encouraged to enrich the show and provide you with additional advertising. Our customers love meeting artisans in person! In quiet times, we encourage artists to bring something to work on.
